

Scholarships Open to Kids for 2019 Summer Camps

The West MI Bowhunters Chapter of SCI will be awarding **10 scholarships worth \$450** each to students for attending 2019 youth camps run by the Michigan United Conservation Clubs (MUCC).



These lucky winners ages 9-14 will be drawn in a raffle to receive fully-paid tuition to attend their choice of a 6-day, 5-night youth camp run by MUCC.

There is no cost to apply for entry into this drawing. WMBH - SCI will hold a drawing at the end of the year to select 10 winning entries. Winners will be announced at the club's annual convention fundraiser next Feb. 23, 2019 at The Pinnacle Center in Hudsonville.

MUCC Camps are held in June or July each summer at the Cedar Lake Outdoor Center at the Waterloo State Recreation Area, near Chelsea. These summer adventures aim to instill a love of the outdoors into children. Camp themes include "Conservation Connections," "Wetland Wonders," "Hunting Heritage" and "Primitive Skills." All campers learn basic firearm shooting safety and can earn their Hunter Safety certificates, too.

The West Michigan Bowhunters – SCI Chapter was founded in 1989 and currently has 60 members. It is committed to protecting hunter's rights, promoting wildlife conservation efforts, and advocating for the wise and sustained use of Michigan's natural resources.
